Serving

We provide tailor made opportunities for you to serve using your gifts and skills within the Youth Ministry of St Andrews Church as well as the ministry of the wider church.

Training

Throughout the year a core part of the internship is dedicated time to invest in theological and leadership studies through our in-house leadership course and practical youth work training practically assessed during the year.

Mission

There is funding available to help you pay for our mission trip to Romania. You will take on the role of helping to organise and run this trip.

There is also opportunity to be part of existing outreach projects as the chance to create something new.

Ministry

Space for you to develop your own ministry. At the start of the year we will talk through what that could look like and how best we can support you in it.



What is our Internship Year all about?

At St Andrews we believe that an internship should be about helping individuals utilise their gifts, skills and passions to be better equipped for the plans God has for them. We want to use our resources to facilitate that within the church context and want to give young adults the opportunity to do this without any great costs or catches. Our desire is to see young adults help shape and grow the church through walking together, learning from each other and seeking the Kingdom of God together.

Our interns spend a year (August-September) being a valued part of the leadership team, working alongside their line manager helping to grow and strengthen the work we do. They get a unique insight into the workings of a vibrant and spirit filled church.





What will my year look like?

The Internship will be shaped around the rhythm of the Youth Work and Church Ministry of St Andrews, with time to develop and nurture your own gifts and areas of interest.

The key focus points will be:

- Youth Spaces (TGI & Clay)
- Connect Group
- Sunday Morning (11-14's, 14'+)
- School CU's (Chosen & Churchdown)
- Youth Weekend Away (Nov)
- Romania Mission Trip (April)
- Training Conferences (all year)
- Theological Training
- Leadership Training

There is also opportunity for you to plug into other areas of church life. Such as: Worship Ministry, Prayer Ministry, Childrens Work, Community Outreach, Messy church and many other areas.

Whats the cost?

Our internship is about empowering, developing and producing young adults who have a better understanding of who they are, who God is and how they can serve Him using the skills and abilities He has given them. We do not want anything to get in the way of that and therefore there are no 'fees' to do the internship, but you will need to be able to support yourself whilst you are with us and be willing to commit the time and passion needed for a eventful year with us!
