Car Parking for St. Andrew's Church
Services & Events When the church car
park is full, please use the public car park
off Church Road, or if open - Churchdown
Junior School on Station Road. If you have
to park on the road outside the church,
please do so with consideration for
residents, and awareness of the Guidance
in the Highway Code. (The 20mph sign is
approximately 10m from Pirton Lane.)
Double yellow lines indicate a prohibition
of waiting at any time

Do not park facing against the traffic flow

Do not park opposite or within 10 metres
(32 feet) of a junction, except in an
authorised parking space.
